

PROJECTS..... **Church and Village Halls** .....



**Little Waltham Church Hall.** The Building took the appearance of a small barn with brick plinth and dark stained weatherboarding, representing the revival of the Essex vernacular tradition.



**St. Mary's Church Hall, Maldon.** The new hall overlooks the Blackwater Estuary. The octagonal pavilion was designed to provide a meeting hall, with ancillary facilities including kitchen, choir vestry and parish office. The octagonal form with its bold buttresses takes the character of a traditional Chapter House, and the stone dressing of the offsets, and projecting eaves appropriately suggest Gothic forms.



**Hoxne Village Hall.** A major refurbishment; more than doubling the floor area, whilst reproducing the exterior details of the original 1879 hall. The extensions provided a new entrance foyer, activity spaces, kitchen, bar lounge, cloakrooms and facilities for the disabled. Runner up in the Suffolk Preservation Society's Alfred Williams Prize.



**St. Andrew's Church Hall, Hatfield Peverel.** The new hall was designed to provide a multi-purpose space. The church is on the site of the Benedictine Priory and as such had significant archaeological design constraints.



**The Jubilee Hall, Aldeburgh.** Various repair and improvement projects, including retractable seating, new entrance, facilities for the disabled and fire precautions work.
